Repentance = Penance?

- Inflict something bad on yourself for having done something bad
- Can a forfeit or some self inflicted punishment deal with your sin?



• Does God require pain for sin?

Repent in Hebrew and Greek

Original Word: שוּב Transliteration: shub Phonetic Spelling: (shoob) Short Definition: to turn back, return



Original Word: μετανοέω Transliteration: metanoeó Phonetic Spelling: (met-an-o-eh'-o) Short Definition: I repent, change my mind Definition: I repent, change my mind, change the inner man (particularly with reference to acceptance of the will of God), repent.

repent

- feel or express sincere regret or remorse about one's wrongdoing or sin.
 "the Padre urged his listeners to repent"
 synonyms: feel remorse for, regret, be sorry for, rue, reproach oneself for, be ashamed of, feel contrite about, wish that one had not done something; More

 view or think of (an action or omission) with deep regret or remorse.
 "more norms to remore the host undermost"
- "Marian came to repent her hasty judgement" archaic
- feel regret or penitence about.
- "I repent me of all I did" .

Two Parts to Repentance:

- 1. Recognise that you were wrong and did wrong
- 2. Turn away from the wrong way and do right!
